- Slates are located in someone's garden/on field boundaries so please do not go onto the properties, just look from the pavement.

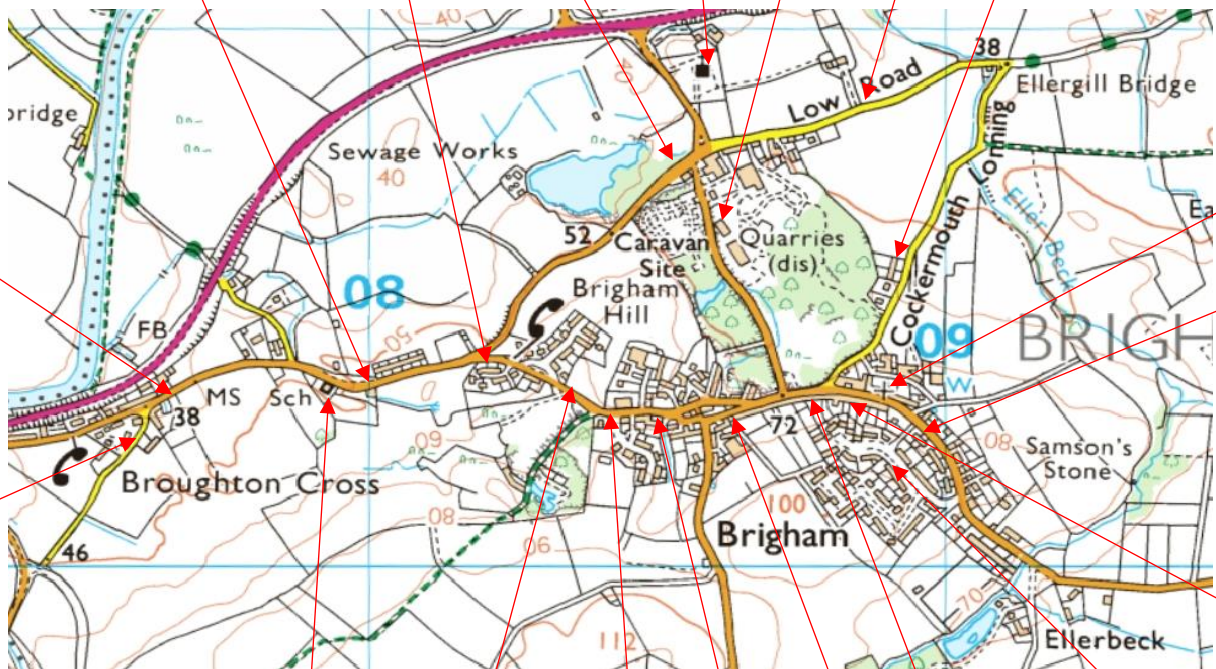
